

Terms and Conditions: The Coding Success Programme

By applying to the programme, your school agrees to the following terms:

1. Programme Commitment

Participating schools commit to engaging with the Coding Success Programme for a **minimum of three years**.

2. School Responsibilities

To support the success and impact of the programme, participating schools agree to:

- Provide images and create social media content that highlights the use of Coding Success resources in your school.
- Complete student and teacher feedback and evaluation forms as requested.
- Participate in Coding Success case studies where possible.

3. CPD Training Participation

- Each school is permitted to nominate **one teacher** to participate in the programme's **Continuing Professional Development (CPD) training**, unless otherwise specified by the programme sponsors.

4. Application Review and Acceptance

The programme reserves the right to accept or decline applications. Applications will be reviewed and prioritised based on the following criteria:

Priority Levels

1. **First Priority:** Schools nominated by the programme sponsors.
2. **Second Priority:** Schools not nominated but located within the designated engagement area, and meeting funder criteria related to free school meals and/or ethnic minority levels within the school*.
3. **Third Priority:** Schools outside the designated engagement area, but who meet funder criteria related to free school meals and/or ethnic minority levels within the school*.

4. **Fourth Priority:** Schools already participating in the programme or those that have independently purchased LEGO® Education SPIKE™ Prime Kits. These schools may:

- Attend CPD training (subject to availability).
- Access the programme's online resources.
- However, they will not be eligible to receive additional LEGO® Education SPIKE™ Prime Kits through the programme.

5. Programme Eligibility

The Coding Success Programme is **only available to schools located within the United Kingdom**.

6. Reserve List

Schools not accepted in the current application cycle will be placed on a **reserve list** and considered for future opportunities as they arise.
